

~ starring art dollies ~




It's the light half of the year, the studio is brightening. Everything is set up for this season's open studio, ready for your visit.

Everyone else must be out in the garden.


It's a busy time of year for planting, pruning, weeding always.

...a few abstract watercolors and some from the Bouquet series....





Roman flower girl backs him up.





This time, please shop on the society 6 site!


